The Student Uniform Policy is designed to promote a consistent and professional appearance among all students. J.M.G.C. Academy believes uniforms contribute to a focused learning environment by reducing distractions and emphasizing academic values.

Our goal is to help students prepare for future academic and professional success. The school reserves the right to take corrective action for any violations of the uniform policy. Consequences for non-compliance may include loss of privileges and exclusion from events or activities.

General Appearance Guidelines

- Hair must be a natural color, neat, and kept out of the eyes.
- Girls: One earring per ear allowed; must be no larger than one inch.
- Boys: No piercings allowed.
- No facial piercings, spacers, or plugs for any student.
- Jewelry must be conservative in style and quantity.
- Boys must be clean-shaven (no facial hair).

Parent Responsibility

It is the responsibility of parents to ensure their child is in full uniform each day upon arrival at school.

Uniform Policy Violations – Consequences

1. Verbal Warning

- o A written notice will be sent home indicating the verbal warning.
- o Parents must sign and return the notice.

2. Written Disciplinary Action Form

Student will lose recess privileges.

3. Written Disciplinary Action Form & Parent Contact

- o Parent must either pick up the student or bring the proper uniform.
- Student may receive In-School Suspension (3 days), which includes exclusion from outdoor park activities.

Daily Uniform Requirements

Girls

- Shirts: Short or long-sleeve polo (burgundy, purple, or grey) with embroidered logo
- Bottoms:
 - o Jumper
 - Skorts

- o Dress
- o Pants
- o Shorts or skorts in black, khaki or plaid (fingertip length or longer)
- Leggings: Solid black or grey (may be worn under bottoms)

Boys

- Shirts: Short or long-sleeve polo (burgundy, purple, or grey) with embroidered logo
- Bottoms:
 - Black or khaki shorts or pants (pleated or flat front)
- Belt: Black or brown

Friday & Field Trip Uniform

Students may wear:

- J.M.G.C. Academy Spirit Shirts (purchase from academy only \$18).
- Jeans (must not be torn, ripped, or frayed)
- Black or grey sweatpants, gym shorts, or jean shorts (must be knee-length)

Approved Outerwear (Black or Gray Only, No Outside Logos)

- Zip-front jacket
- Crew neck sweater
- Cardigan
- Blazer

Uniform Purchase and Embroidery

- Burgundy, purple, or grey polo shirts may be purchased independently (e.g., Walmart, Amazon).
- Shirts should be brought to school grounds or contact embroider independently for J.M.G.C. Academy logo embroidery. *TWO WEEKS TURN-AROUND TIME*
